The Alamo Bowl is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, December 29, 2007. Tentative dates for the trip are from Wednesday, December 26 to Tuesday, January 1. The trip will include activities that will be educational as well as interesting for the students. 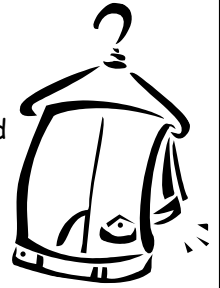

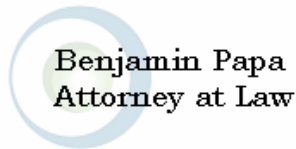
