Band Trip 2007-2008

December 26 - January 1



The Brentwood High School Marching Band will be performing at the 2007 Alamo Bowl in San Antonio on Saturday, December 29, 2007. The *tentative* itinerary is as follows. Buses will leave from Brentwood High School early Wednesday, December 26. The band will stay overnight in Dallas before arriving in San Antonio mid-day Thursday. Thursday afternoon they'll rehearse for the Alamo Bowl before enjoying dinner on the Riverwalk. They'll have a full day of guided sight-seeing activities on Friday, including the Alamo, IMAX Theater, Mission San Jose, and a boat ride on the Paseo del Rio. Friday evening there is an evening gala awards dinner and dance for all bands participating in the Alamo Bowl. Saturday includes a mass band rehearsal at the Alamo Bowl, an afternoon at the Riverwalk and the game in the evening. On Sunday, they'll visit Sea World and on Monday, they'll visit the San Antonio Zoo in the morning and depart for home in the afternoon with a stop en route in Texarkana on December 31. They'll arrive in Brentwood late afternoon on Tuesday, January 1. While in San Antonio, the band may be performing a concert at Brooke Army Medical Center.

A non-refundable \$50 deposit and the signed (by parent or guardian) registration form is required by Monday, May 21 for all students and family members who plan to participate.

The total cost of the trip is expected to be between \$950 and \$990 for a quad or \$1070 to \$1110 for a double. Four payments of \$200 will be required each month from August through November, with the balance due by December 1. Parents and family members who wish to 'tag-along' on the trip have a choice of paying for the full plan (same as the students) or a separate package that *excludes* all transportation to/from/in San Antonio. The registration form with payment schedule is enclosed with this newsletter.

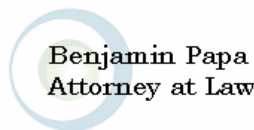
